

NOBODY LIKES WORMS IN APPLES.

WELL, NEITHER DO WE. THE SAME GOES FOR THE PRODUCERS, HENCE THE SPRAYING TO KEEP PESTS AWAY. THE VOLUME AND TIME OF SPRAYING THE INSECTICIDES ARE IMPORTANT QUESTIONS, THOUGH.

Some pest insects can be caught well using pheromone traps. The volumes of the daily catches allow deduction of the intensity of swarming, from which the time of mass egg laying can be defined. The sticky cards used commonly today help greatly in determining the time prevention should start but their daily control over large areas or distant plots is quite labour intensive. And if the data of a few months are omitted from reading, the entire prevention action may become uncertain.
